**52 Cases of External Humeral Epicondylitis (Tennis Elbow) Treated by
Acupuncture and Moxibustion**

The 52 cases, a mixture of acute and chronic, were treated by local and distal needling, after which 3-5 moxa cones on slices of ginger were burnt at the sites of needling. Results were: 25 cases cured, 19 marked relief, 6 improved and two had no effect, with an improvement rate of 96.15%.
